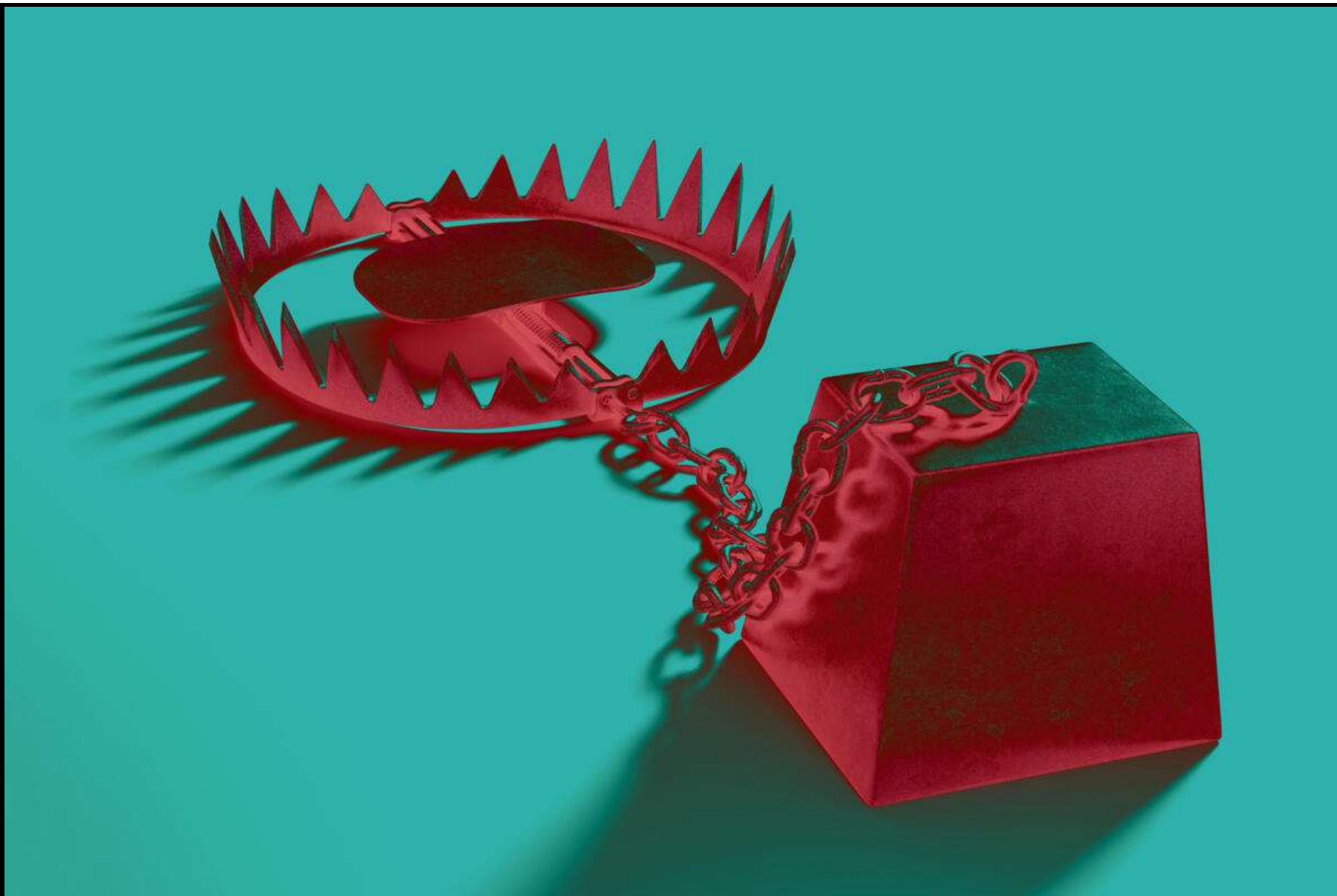
Then Esau ran to meet him and embraced him, threw his arms around his neck, and kissed him. And they both wept. Gen. 33:4

JOE: I see God that it is holding me back in trusting others when I am in situations that require me to perform a certain way. What is one thing I can do to begin releasing this to you?


GOD: Why don't you begin by praying for that person every day. As you do, I will change your perspective and begin to heal that wound in you.
