- Seeks consultation with the wicked.

Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble. Proverbs 13:20 (NLT)



NOR STANDS IN THE PATH OF SINNERS

- Stands around with sinners (NLT)
- Shares the sinner's way (TPT)
- Dead end way (MSG)

Don't team up with those who are unbelievers. How can righteousness be a partner with wickedness? How can light live with darkness? 2 Corinthians 6:14



NOR SITS IN THE SEAT OF THE SCORNFUL

- Sit (down to rest) in seat of scoffers (ridiculers) (AMP)
- Join in with mockers (NLT)
- Found sitting in scorner's seat (TPT)
- Smart mouth college (MSG)
- Make fun of.
- Sneers, disagreeable, unpleasant, contempt.

Mockers can get a whole town agitated, but the wise will calm anger. Proverbs 29:8
